- x While an instructor has the right to refuse to allow-**upake**r other accommoda permitted to provide such accommodations.

Therefore, faculty are encouraged to include a statement in their course syl policy and student responsibilities regarding conflicts with curricular and ext related student events (see sample syllabus language, below).
